Replacing BCSC Vancouver with Ontario Superior Court of Justice · Toronto Registry · Civil Submissions Online e-filing

1 · THE PROBLEM WITH BCSC

The Pass 2 / 3 / 4 filing package was drafted for the Supreme Court of British Columbia, Vancouver Registry, on the strategic grounds that British Columbia's Wills, Estates and Succession Act permits forum-of-convenience for estate disputes involving cross-provincial defendants, and that BCSC has the most developed Mareva-injunction jurisprudence in Canada. That strategic analysis remains sound, but it failed one practical test: the lead Plaintiff Francesco Giovanni Longo resides in Windsor, Ontario, cannot travel to Vancouver, and cannot reliably rely on BCSC's Court Services Online for a self-represented multi-plaintiff NOCC of this complexity.

2 · THE SOLUTION — ONTARIO SUPERIOR COURT OF JUSTICE · TORONTO REGISTRY

The correct forum is the Ontario Superior Court of Justice, filed at the Toronto Registry (393 University Avenue, 10th Floor, Toronto, Ontario

M5G 1E6), via Ontario's **Civil Submissions Online** electronic-filing portal at www.ontario.ca/CivilSubmissionsOnline.

Why Toronto, not Windsor

Windsor Superior Court of Justice cannot be the filing registry because **Defendant The Honourable Justice John Paul Howard** is a sitting judge of that court. Filing at Windsor would face immediate local-judge-capture risk and recusal chaos. Toronto is the neutral administrative seat, is the seat of the Office of the Chief Justice of Ontario, and is the appropriate registry for any civil action in which a Superior Court judge is a named defendant.

Subject-matter fit

- The estate is an Ontario estate (Ontario Estate File 2017-036367).
- The real property, corporate entities, insurance policies (Sun Life Canada HQ, Empire Life Kingston ON), and police jurisdiction are all Ontario.
- An existing Ontario civil proceeding CV-17-25300 creates venue anchor.
- All 21 named individual and institutional Defendants reside or carry on business in Ontario.

Self-rep e-filing

Ontario's Civil Submissions Online accepts a self-represented plaintiff's Statement of Claim (equivalent to BCSC's Notice of Civil Claim) as a PDF upload with credit-card payment of the filing fee (CAD \$243 for a general proceeding; motion for Mareva injunction CAD \$127). The court issues the document with a court file number within 3-5 business days, and the plaintiff then serves the defendants.

4 • WHAT DOES NOT CHANGE

- The 21-defendant caption stays exactly as Pass 5 Addendum specifies.
- The Mareva cap stays at CAD \$510,000,000.
- Exhibits 14–22 all remain in force (the substantive content is court-agnostic).
- Francesco Longo files on his own signature under the Unified Tort Memo (Filing #13); co-claimants join at first appearance by viva voce testimony or later-filed affidavits.

- The factual foundation — autopsy temporal-impossibility forgery, Bart Segan Nov 16 2016 tape, Dan Potvin 70-minute confession call, Empire Life corporate policy, disposition absurdity — all remain.

5 · RELIEF SOUGHT (unchanged, Ontario-formatted)

The Plaintiffs claim against the Defendants, and each of them, jointly and severally:

1. **General, aggravated, and punitive damages** in an amount not less than **CAD \$510,000,000**, per the multiplier schedule at Exhibit 17, with upward adjustment reserved on Norwich disclosure of the Empire Life policy face value.
2. **Mareva Injunction** worldwide freezing assets of all 21 named Defendants to a cap of CAD \$510,000,000 (Filing #09, amended per Pass 5).
3. **Norwich Pharmacal Order** compelling production from 22 Information Custodians, with 7-day response window for the three Primary Disclosure Targets (Sun Life Financial, Empire Life Financial Corporation, Ontario Centre for Forensic Sciences).
4. **Mandatory Judicial Review** of (a) the Raffi Ceylan autopsy signed 5 days before death, (b) the forged Transfer of Ownership document, (c) the mediation presided by Mary Jo Nolan in conflict of interest, and (d) the Windsor Police Service's three-investigator non-pursuit.
5. **Exhumation Order** under Ontario's Coroners Act R.S.O. 1990, c. C.37, s. 15, with independent toxicological examination by a laboratory other than the Ontario Centre for Forensic Sciences.
6. **Referral** for criminal investigation to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (not Windsor Police, for reasons set out at Exhibit 20), the Ontario Provincial Police, and the Special Investigations Unit of Ontario.
7. **Media publication order** — the pleadings and all Pass 5 Exhibits to be publicly docketed on the Ontario CSJ e-docket without sealing order, so the public interest in this matter is served and a public investigation can proceed.

8. **Costs** on a substantial-indemnity basis.

6 • NEXT STEPS

1. Pop signs Filing #05A (Francesco Longo Affidavit, Ontario-format, prepared this Pass 5). Electronic signature or printed-and-scanned acceptable under Ontario Electronic Commerce Act 2000.
2. Filing package is uploaded as PDFs to Civil Submissions Online.
3. Filing fee CAD \$243 plus CAD \$127 motion fee = CAD \$370 charged to credit card.
4. Court issues file number within 3-5 business days.
5. Francesco serves the 21 Defendants via process server or courier per Rule 16 of the Rules of Civil Procedure.
6. First appearance in Toronto. Lucy, Armin, and Betty give viva voce testimony at that appearance or sign their affidavits before that date — their choice.
