I. OVERVIEW

The Windsor Cartel Exposed hub documents a systemic criminal conspiracy under s. 465(1)(c) Criminal Code, spanning 2004–2026 (22+ years), involving six victims, 249+ dismissed complaints (100% dismissal rate), \$1.2M+ financial losses, and 90+ smoking guns (19 documented, 97 in master file). All claims are allegations pending judicial determination, supported by 26+ verified exhibits, including audio recordings and emails. Filing intended under s. 60 Courts of Justice Act, RSO 1990, c C.43, and Rules 37, 38 Rules of Civil Procedure.
